HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

The Philippine American Society of Ohio was founded in 1967 by a handful of Filipinos. It was a vision that survived over the years and is now true legacy of the Filipino Community here in the greater Cleveland area.

It was initially named Philippine-American Society of Northeast Ohio (PANO), however, it was necessary to change the name to include members outside of Northeast Ohio, hence, PASO, or Philippine-American Society of Ohio was born. It also allowed membership to those with Filipino affinity.

The organization's purposes are to promote the welfare and interests of the Filipino-American in Ohio as well as preserve and perpetuate the Filipino heritage and culture.

The organization's dream to build a center actually started in the late 1960's but it never came to fruition until 1997 when the center was inaugurated. The center is the pride of the Filipino-American community and has been the center of several cultural, civic and social gatherings.
